POSITIVE METHODS

We use only positive reinforcement methods and work with you and your dog to achieve the results you want without causing pain, stress or discomfort. Dogs are encouraged to feel confident with the learning progress and develop skills without fear or pressure. We promote responsible dog ownership in a caring environment.

PUPPY SCHOOL

Puppies between the ages of 8 and 14 weeks may attend. Classes are held inside, in a safe learning environment. Socialisation, early learning and advice on toilet training, biting, and all of the other wonderful things that puppies do. There is a maximum of 8 puppies per class. The course runs for 4 weeks, with an hour lesson each week.

PET DOG TRAINING

Basic, Intermediate, Advanced, Graduate and Masters level courses available. We help you train your dog to use good manners and to become a socially accepted member of the family and the community. Courses run for 9 weeks with an hour lesson each week and have a maximum of 10 dogs per class. Each lesson is one hour long.

AGILITY AND DOG SPORTS

Agility is a fun activity for dogs and their families. Agility helps build confidence in dogs and promotes a strong bond between the dog and its family as they learn to negotiate a number of obstacles, jumps and tunnels. Classes for tricks, flyball, freestyle dancing and other fun activities are scheduled throughout the year. Phone for updates!

DOGGY DAY CARE

Is your dog bored at home - or do you not have enough time to exercise him every day? Doggy Day Care operates three days a week and provides a fun, safe and enjoyable day out for your dog. Fully fenced grounds and qualified carers. Dogs are free running, not caged, penned or tied up. To be eligible, dogs must be sociable and not aggressive towards others.

BEHAVIOURAL ADVICE & PRIVATE LESSONS

Advice and assistance with all your dog problems. Jumping up, separation anxiety, unwanted behaviours? Private lessons are available at the club grounds or at your own home. All dogs are treated in a positive caring way as we help you teach your dog the manners you wish he had! Referrals are given if problems exceed our expertise.

INSTRUCTORS

Our instructors have all had professional training through the Delta Society Australia. They use positive methods and have a "do no harm" policy. They are all experienced dog owners and understand how important your four-legged family member is to you. They have a strong commitment to dogs and their families, and are actively involved in many dog activities.

ADVOCACY

The Holdfast Dog Centre is an initiative of the Holdfast Bay Dog Owners Association. The Association has its foundations as an advocacy group who liaise with local and state government organisations to promote responsible dog ownership and protect the rights of dog owners and their dogs through representation.
